Diversity Training Opportunity

Hollywood Family Trust is seeking to contribute towards a better understanding of Cultural and Diversity issues by bringing together a group from differing sections of the community in a bid to improve integration in a relaxed, learning environment.

Hollywood Family Trust has organised a three part series of interactive workshops designed to explore issues such as prejudice, differing worldviews, and the role that language and values have on cultures and groups.

The classes for adults will be held in the Community & Family Centre, 108 High Street, Hollywood on Tuesday nights at 7pm on 1st, 8th and 15th April.

Hollywood Family Trust are hosting the course because of the change occurring in the Northern Irish community with the increasing numbers of foreign nationals living and working in the province, and also the increased opportunities for people to travel to more remote destinations and experience non-western cultures. Issues of prejudice, sectarianism and racism, often exist because people have just not had the opportunity to experience or learn about other cultures so the training will offer opportunity to explore some of these issues.

The course will be sponsored by North Down Borough Council's Good Relations Strategy and Programme. The course will help people understand themselves as well as realising why other people are the way they are. It will be a fun filled learning experience for those who attend.
