

Free History Book Course



**Alexandra Park, Grove Park and Waterworks
-People's History Initiative is currently running a People's
History Course.**

**Would you like to tell the story of Alexandra Park, Grove Park
and the Waterworks in photographs and spoken and written
memories and present this in an exhibition or book?**

During the course your group will pick a theme and time period relevant to their community, which they wish to explore.

Participants will have the opportunity to collect information and discuss the theme they have chosen. They will learn how to study old photographs and newspapers, how to interview people and collect their stories and how to use street directories to find out about the past.

Participants will learn how to present the information of the history of their community in exhibition or booklet format. This exhibition or booklet can then be launched locally.

The course also allows participants reflect on their findings about the past and use this in future plans for their community. This course is 12 sessions, each session is 2 hours. It is accredited at OCN Level 2. This course is free.
